- **1. REGISTRATION FEE**: includes information pack, free entry to evening events, Sunday cake raid at Keir and administration costs. All tickets etc. to be collected from the Rally HQ, Penpont.

- **3. OTHER MEALS**: are available from the Three Villages Community Café. The Café will be open on the evening of Thursday 22nd May for early campers. Breakfast will be available each day in the café from 8.00am and packed lunches can be ordered the day before to be collected at breakfast.
- **4. CAMPING PITCHES AND ON-SITE ACCOMMODATION**: Main Glebe Field, Penpont. Showers and toilets available in the park. There will also be a small marquee in the park for storing equipment and hanging wet clothes if necessary.
