BARNSOUL SITE BOOKING

We are again holding this popular Rally at the beautifully located Barnsoul Caravan Park near Shawhead in Dumfriesshire on the 2015 May Bank Holiday weekend (May 22nd to 25th). As in 2013 the Rally Registration and meals booking is separate from accommodation booking. The latter is directly with the site either through **writing to them, or by phone.** The pitches etc. have been reserved for us for a few months – if (in this period) you try to book using the website, the site will appear to be full. Despite the Rally being held on a premium Bank Holiday Weekend we have negotiated a 5% discount for ALL Rallyists whether camping, using a motor home or caravan, or hiring a Pod or Lodge. The accommodation and price structure has changed some since 2013, and this is summarised below. The basic prices per night for KM Rallyists are:-

- 1. Small 1 person Tent (by bicycle or car): £11.40
- 2. Standard 2 Person Tent (by car or bicycle): £15.20
- 3. Large 4 Person Tent (by car or bicycle): £26.60
- 4. Caravan or Motorhome: Mon to Thurs £17.10 and Fri to Sun £19.00 (incl 2 people and electric hook up)
- 5. Apex Pods: Mon to Thurs £38.00 and Fri to Sun £40.85 (incl car, 2 people and electricity)
- 6. Little Lodges: Mon to Thurs £42.75 and Fri to Sun £45.60 (incl car, 2 people and electricity)

When booking by phone or by post, please state that you are booking as a KM Rallyist and the person taking the booking will apply the discount at the time. For extras (other than the pitch booking, eg extra adults, dogs etc) please contact Barnsoul for information. Please note that the Barnsoul booking conditions will apply to both pitch and wigwam bookings. And given that this is a Bank Holiday weekend you are recommended to book pitches, pods etc ASAP – we cannot guarantee availability of accommodation.

The site is open for the Rally(ists) from Thurs 21st to Tues 26th.



- 1 REGISTRATION FEE includes information pack, route cards, Sunday breakfast ticket, entry to evening events, and administration costs.
- 2 CAMPING PITCHES AND ON SITE ACCOMODATION: Please book direct with Barnsoul. See the first page.
- **3 ALTERNATIVE ACCOMMODATION.** For all alternative accommodation please contact the Dumfries TIC on 01387 253862, dumfriestic@visitscotland.com or www.visitsouthwestscotland.com for B&B information etc (see Note 12)
- **4 EVENING MEALS**: At Shawhead Hall, 1.5 miles from camp site. A 2-course meal of excellent quality, generous helpings (main course and sweet, tea/coffee; veggie option). Same caterer as last year.
- **5 SOCIAL EVENING:** Friday 8pm, Shawhead Hall. Wine, tea and coffee, juice and nibbles provided. Meet and chat with other Rallyists.
- **6 ENTERTAINMENT:** Saturday 8pm, Shawhead Hall. TBA
- 7 QUIZ: Sunday, 8pm, Shawhead Hall. Join a team and pool your knowledge. Fun for everyone, including children, and prizes!
- **8 TOURING RIDES**: 3 graded rides daily depart Barnsoul approx.9.30am onwards, (excl. Sunday, when they depart Keir after Cyclists' Breakfast, around 12 pm). B rides 45 65 miles, C rides 30 45, D/ family rides under 30 miles.
- 9 No arrangements are made for meals on rides but we try to stop at cafes/shops. Riders should check with leader or route card for options.
- 10 CYCLISTS' BREAKFAST: at Keir Church Hall, Sunday 11am. Keir is a 'D' ride away from Barnsoul. Entry by ticket, free on registration.
